Strategy for Directors

The skills you need to understand organisational finance and the relationship between financial and operational strategies.



Diploma in Company Direction

The Diploma requires you to take the knowledge gained at Certificate level and consider how it should be applied in a board room environment.



Chartered Director Qualification

To become a chartered director, you will be asked to demonstrate how you have used the knowledge, skills and mindset required of a director within your own organisation.

Being awarded chartered director status with the IoD isn't the culmination of your journey as a director. It's a springboard to the next chapter in your development as a professional director and leader, helping you accelerate your career.

The framework is the first of its kind, setting out 15 core Director Competency Framework competencies across three dimensions - knowledge, skills and mindset. Competencies that, when combined, characterise strong and effective directors and leaders. It provides an accessible, measurable and achievable guide to becoming a better director, regardless of sector, industry or role.


It is also used by organisations to balance competencies across their boards and senior leadership teams, by enabling them to:

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The first stage in our Chartered Director Programme equips you with the skills, knowledge and mindset needed to function as an effective director at board level. The certificate covers a wide range of topics including governance, finance, strategy and leadership. It is accredited at Bachelors level (18 credits) on the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF).



Leadership for Directors

This course gives you an understanding of the key competencies required to be an effective leader at board level.

During the course you will assess different leadership and decision-making techniques, determine how to build and sustain high-performing teams, and evaluate how these can be applied in your own organisation for maximum impact.

Objectives

To give you the knowledge and skills to:

- understand how leadership can be defined and understood in relation to the director's role on the board
- develop greater awareness of yourself and the motivations and behaviours of others
- create a culture that constructively engages others in the organisation to achieve its strategic objectives, and to respond effectively to crisis and change
- identify how leaders create influence and impact within and beyond the organisation and assess relevant stakeholder engagement strategies

Finance for Non-Finance Directors

This course has been designed to demystify the world of finance for non-finance directors and senior managers. It will give you an understanding of key financial concepts and terminology. You will leave with the skills and knowledge needed to evaluate business plans, question financial information and contribute more effectively to boardroom decision making.

Objectives

To give you the knowledge and skills to:

- evaluate your role and responsibilities in relation to finance
- understand the relationship between financial and corporate strategies
- outline ways of ensuring management reporting is effective and enables delivery of the organisation's strategy
- understand the key factors around funding requirements and funding options

Benefits

This course will give you what you need to assess the financial health of your organisation. It will enable you to understand financial terminology, use financial ratios

The second stage on the path to becoming a chartered director is accredited at Masters level (four credits) on the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF). The diploma is made up of three days of practical, simulated boardroom challenges in a safe environment.



Diploma in Company Direction

Objectives

The diploma assesses your ability to apply the skills and knowledge gained through your certificate courses and your real-life board room experience to boost your expertise and confidence as a director. Completing the Developing Board Performance course is essential before you take the diploma examination. Not only will it prepare you for the examination, it will have an immediate impact on your performance as a director.

The diploma will give you:

- an understanding of your board's role, its dynamic, power, influence and conflicts
- insight into key topics such as risk and crisis management, decision making and mergers and acquisitions
- access to techniques and tools to improve your own competencies and evaluate the performance of your board and its members

Course content is designed by directors for directors and will prepare you for the diploma exam allowing you to move on to the final stage of the Chartered Director Programme.

Developing Board Performance module

The course covers the essential aspects of the board's role in corporate governance and risk management, and an introduction to the duties and legal responsibilities of a director. The course contributes to the 30 total learning hours required by the diploma and is compulsory.

Chartered Director Qualification

Objectives

As the final step in our Chartered Director Programme, this qualification recognises the high standards and capabilities needed to be a director in today's world.

Benefits

Chartered director status signals that you're committed to your role and the contribution you make as director of your organisation. It enables you to demonstrate your commitment to CPD by giving you access to special events that will broaden your network and keep you informed of the latest insights and best practice. You will also have access to IoD Academy for the rest of your career, ensuring that you keep up with changing business practices and policies.

Eligibility

To apply for the Chartered Director Qualification, you must:

- be a full member or Fellow of the IoD
- have obtained a pass or above in the Certificate in Company Direction in the last 10 years
- have obtained a pass or above in the Diploma in Company Direction in the last 10 years

The role(s) you detail in your application should include at least one that has been held in the last five years. You will need to have served a minimum of three years in one of the roles you list in your application.

Process

The Chartered Director Qualification assesses your practical director experience in three stages:

- application
- overview of experience
- formal interview conducted by two chartered director interviewers

The assessment is based on five areas central to organisational direction and governance:

- vision, purpose, values and ethics
- strategic thinking and stakeholder management
- delegation to management
- discharging your duties as a director and as a competent member of a collective and responsible body
- exercising effective and accountable leadership

Examinations

IoD awards, certificate and diploma level qualifications are internationally recognised and credit rated under the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF).

Exams are flexible and can be taken at various dates throughout the year at a time which works best for you. They are completed using a computer-based testing system and are remotely invigilated allowing you to choose when and where you take them. Full details of exam dates are listed on iod.com and can be booked via the website.

Certificate

You will need to pass an exam at the end of each of the four certificate modules. Each exam is made up of 16 multiple choice questions and lasts 45 minutes. You'll receive your results within a few weeks.

All information regarding our exams including terms and conditions, regulations and policies and exemptions, can be found in the examinations section on iod.com.

Diploma

To obtain the diploma, you'll need to complete the Developing Board Performance module and pass a three-hour exam. We publish a standard exam question beforehand, which you'll need to answer in relation to a case study released on the day of the exam.
